## **Scope and Content**

The Commander Michael Berry Collection consists of briefing notes, calendars, schedules, thank you notes, notebooks, reports, newspaper clippings, printouts of emails, etc. All documents are related to Camp David, the presidential retreat.

## **Biographical Note**

Camp David is the country retreat for the President of the United States. It is located near Thurmont, Maryland. Its official name is the Naval Support Facility Thurmont. Camp David has been used by every president originating with President Franklin D. Roosevelt. During World War II President Roosevelt wanted a retreat that was within proximity to Washington D.C. that could also maintain Presidential security. In 1942 President Roosevelt had originally named the compound Shangri-La. During President Dwight D. Eisenhower's administration the compound was renamed Camp David in honor of the President's grandson. The current names for the cabins are also believed to have originated from the Eisenhower administration. The subsequent presidents after President Roosevelt have all frequented Camp David at their own leisure, typically as weekend trips because of its convenient location. President George Bush was a frequent visitor of Camp David during his presidency and hosted numerous foreign leaders at this venue. Camp David was also used for meetings and family visits under the Bush administration. The camp continues to be utilized as a presidential retreat right up to the current administration.

These Camp David records were created or obtained by Commander Michael Berry who served as Commander of Camp David from July 1988 to August 1991. In this capacity he was responsible for maintaining the camp, providing security, and supervising personnel. Originally from Kansas City, Kansas. Commander Berry was commissioned as an Ensign, Civil Engineer Corps, in 1972 at the Officer Candidate School, Newport, RI. Prior to being the Commander of Camp David, Commander Berry served as the Deputy Director, Acquisition Department of the Atlantic Division, Naval Facilities Engineering Command, Norfolk, VA.

Series: Camp David Records (Boxes 1–12)

The Files of Commander Berry consist of 23 sub-series. The largest sub-series is the Visit Packages and Visit Reports. The Visit Packages and Visit Reports provides details from Presidential and Vice-Presidential visits during Commander Berry's tenure. The next three largest sub-series are PROF NOTES, Notebooks and CO's Day-Timer Planner, Monthly Inserts. PROF NOTES include printouts of the early form of emails used in the White House between Commander Berry and other staff. Notebooks include notes from Commander Berry throughout his tenure detailing various conversations. The CO's Day-Timer planner, Monthly Inserts includes Commander Berry's schedules, appointments, and daily action items. The remaining sub-series are relatively small and consist of thank you notes, calendars, newspaper clippings, and miscellaneous topics.

Sub-series: Visit Packages and Visit Reports (Boxes 1–5)

The Visit Packages and Visit Reports files were used by Commander Michael Berry. Visit Packages were prepared in advance of visits as an operations order and plan detailing the expectations of each visit. The Visit Packages were used by the Navy and Marine personnel as a guide for accomplishing the missions of the visit. Visit Reports were prepared after the completion of a visit by the Navy Command Duty Officer. These reports provided a narrative of exactly what occurred during the visit. These files cover the range of dates from January 1989 to August 1991 when Commander Berry was transferred to his next duty station.

Sub-series: Summary of Documents Related to Camp David (Box 6)

This file contains a summary of the documents donated to the George Bush Presidential Library by

Commander Michael Berry. Also included is a CD with scanned PDFs of the documents in the collection.

Sub-series: Camp David History (Box 6)

This file contains a brief history of Camp David's origins and the use of the camp throughout the presidential administrations from President Franklin D. Roosevelt to President Bill Clinton.

Sub-series: Thank You Notes (Box 6)

This file contains thank you notes that Commander and Mrs. Berry received while at Camp David from 1988 to 1991.

Sub-series: Decorating the White House for Christmas (Box 6)

This file contains information relating to Commander Berry's wife, Deloris, involvement in decorating the White House for Christmas in 1989, 1990 and 1991.

Sub-series: NSF Thurmont Wardroom and NSF Wives Club (Box 6)

This file contains items related to the NSF Wardroom and NSF wives club.

Sub-series: Camp David Chapel Papers (Box 6)

This file contains information related to the chapel at Camp David. This includes worship bulletins and meeting minutes pertaining to the Camp David Chapel Fund.

Sub-series: <u>Invitations to Camp David Related Special Events</u> (Box 6)

This file contains invitations and announcements for several events and ceremonies related to Camp David.

Sub-series: Invitations to White House Events (Box 6)

This file contains invitations and announcements for several events and ceremonies at the White House, Vice President's House and White House entities.

Sub-series: Camp David Change of Command (Box 7)

These files contains documents related to the Change of Command in July 1988 when Commander Michael Berry replaced Commander Jim Broadus. These files also include the Change of Command on August 6, 1991 when Commander Joe Camp replaced Commander Michael Berry. Documents inside include turnover notes, turnover schedules, guest lists, program, etc.

Sub-series: Personnel Lists and Rosters (Box 7)

This file contains personnel lists and rosters used at Camp David by the Commanding Officer from 1988 to 1991. This file includes the White House Military office roster, telephone directory, etc.

Sub-series: Briefing Notes for One on One Meetings With Deputy WHMO Director (Box 7)

This file contains briefing notes used by Commander Berry in Briefing to Captain Skip Moyer, Deputy WHMO Director, concerning all aspects of Camp David operations.

Sub-series: Presidential Calendars (Box 7)

This file contains Presidential and First Lady Calendars used by Commander Berry for planning command activities, visits, training, and meetings.

Sub-series: Action Item Lists and Department Status Reports (Box 7)

This file contains documents related to the Commanding Officer's list of action items, projects, improvements, and initiatives underway at Camp David, along with status reports provided by the various Camp David department heads to the CO.

Sub-series: PROF NOTES (Boxes 8-9)

These files contain printouts of the early forms of emails used in the White House during this time. These files include communications between Commander Berry and support staff in the White House, the White House Military Office, Secret Service, etc.

Sub-series: Camp David Weekly Reports to the White House Military Office (Box 9)

This file contains the weekly reports that Commander Berry submitted to the director of the White House Military Office. These reports include significant events, projects, Presidential interest items, etc.

Sub-series: Notebooks (Boxes 10–11)

These files include notebooks used by Commander Berry while he was the Commanding Officer at Camp David. This notebooks contain notes taken by Commander Berry from conversations with the President, the First Lady, White House Military Office, Secret Service, National Park Service, etc.

Sub-series: CO's Seabee Memorial Calendars (Box 11)

This file contains monthly calendars for the Commanding Officer of Camp David used for planning command activities, visits, training and meetings.

Sub-series: CO's Day-Timer Planner, Monthly Inserts (Boxes 11–12)

These files contain the schedules, daily action items, appointments and notes used by Commander Berry.

Sub-series: Diaries and Letters (Box 12)

This file contains letters Commander Berry's wife, Deloris, wrote to family during their tour at Camp David. Also included are entries from Commander Berry's diaries from his tour at Camp David.

Sub-series: Personal Correspondence (Box 12)

This file contains personal correspondences to Commander Michael Berry. Included in this file are letters from President Ronald Reagan and President George Bush.

Sub-series: Camp David Schedules (Box 12)

This file contains various Camp David schedules and a map of Camp David.

Sub-series: Newspaper Clippings (Box 12)

These files contain various newspaper clippings relating to Camp David and President George Bush.
