The Commander Clifford Steele Cooper, Sr. Collection consists of a U.S.S. San Jacinto Strike Report list and a crew list with respective emergency contacts.

Biographical Note

Clifford Steele Cooper, Sr. graduated from the U.S. Naval Academy at Annapolis, Class of 1927 and obtained the rank of U.S. Navy Rear Admiral by his retirement. He served as a Commander 2d Carrier

Task Force Pacific aboard the U.S.S. San Jacinto during World War II and was presented the Silver Star for conspicuous gallantry and intrepidity as Executive Officer of the U.S.S. San Jacinto, in action against enemy Japanese forces at Leyte and Samar in the Philippine islands from 27 September to 2 November 1944.
