#### **Scope and Content**

The Dan Dalrymple Collection consists of an original 1948 magazine *Harper's Bazaar* which includes an advertisement featuring Barbara and George Bush when he was a student at Yale University. The advertisement is for Bates Fabric's Victoria bedroom collection and features a representation of the Bushes entertaining in their apartment with matching bedspread and draperies.

# **Biographical Note**

Harper's Bazaar was first published in 1867 as a weekly newspaper catering to women in the middle and upper classes, featuring fashions from Europe, particularly France. In 1901 its publication moved to a monthly magazine which still continues today. Harper's Bazaar is owned and operated by the Heart Corporation in the United States. There is no apparent connection of the young couple to Harper's

*Bazaar*. However, Barbara Bush's father, Marvin Pierce, was president of the McCall Corporation which published both the *Redbook* and *McCall's* magazines.
