Biographical Note

James (Jim) C. Sims was a salesman for Shell Chemical and Republican Precinct Chairman in Pasadena, Texas during the time that George Bush held the same office in his neighborhood of Houston. When George Bush ran for Harris County Chairman in the early 1960s, Mr. Sims supported and campaigned for him. This relationship continued through the years and these vice presidential notes demonstrate their friendship.
