Subject of Material

The majority of this material was sent to the Hamermans shortly after the Operation Solomon rescue and is an update letter from the American Association for Ethiopian Jews regarding the airlift which moved up to 15,000 Ethiopian Jews to Israel. The Congressional letter is a follow-up response to a visit by the Religious Action Center group.
