Biographical Note

Established in 1885, *American Home and Gardens* magazine featured grand or unusual homes in the United States. In July 1905, this publication did a short feature on "Rock Ledge," the summer home of George H. Walker, father to Dorothy Walker Bush, and grandfather to George H.W. Bush. At the time of the article, the home was recently completed and decorated. Photographs in the article depict the design and fashionable nature of the structure.
