Collection is open to all researchers. Access to Bush Vice Presidential Records is governed by the Freedom of Information Act (FOIA)(5 USC 552 as amended) and the Presidential Records Act (PRA)(44 USC 22) and therefore records may be restricted in whole or in part in accordance with legal exemptions.

Copyright

Documents in this collection that were prepared by officials of the United States government as part of their official duties are in the public domain. Researchers are advised to consult the copyright law of the United States (Title 17, USC) which governs the making of photocopies or other reproductions of copyrighted material.

Provenance

Official records of George Bush's vice presidency are housed at the George Bush Presidential Library and administered by the National Archives and Records Administration (NARA) under the provisions of the Presidential Records Act (PRA).

Processed By

Staff Archivists, March 2003. Previously restricted materials are added as they are released.

Scope and Content

The materials in FOIA 2001-2590-F are a selective, not necessarily all inclusive, body of documents responsive to the topic of the FOIA. Researchers should consult the archivist about related materials.

FOIA 2001-2590-F contains documents related to Vice President Bush's involvement in or reaction to the Reagan Administration's attempt in 1982 to give tax exempt status to Bob Jones University and other segregated academies. This FOIA consists of draft presidential statements on tax exemptions for private institutions.

System of Arrangement

Records that are responsive to this FOIA request were found in one collection areas—Bush Vice Presidential Records: White House Staff and Office Files. As policy, Staff and Office Files are processed at the folder level, that is, individual documents are not selected and removed from a folder for processing. While this method maintains folder integrity, it frequently results in the incidental processing of documents that are not wholly responsive to the subject area.
