### **Extent**

#### **Access**

Collection is open to all researchers. Access to Bush Presidential Records, Bush Vice Presidential Records, and Quayle Vice Presidential Records is governed by the Freedom of Information Act (FOIA)(5 USC 552 as amended) and the Presidential Records Act (PRA)(44 USC 22) and therefore records may be restricted in whole or in part in accordance with legal exemptions.

## Copyright

Documents in this collection that were prepared by officials of the United States government as part of their official duties are in the public domain. Researchers are advised to consult the copyright law of the United States (Title 17, USC) which governs the making of photocopies or other reproductions of copyrighted material.

#### **Provenance**

Official records of George Bush's presidency and vice presidency are housed at the George Bush Presidential Library and administered by the National Archives and Records Administration (NARA) under the provisions of the Presidential Records Act (PRA).

#### **Processed By**

Staff Archivists, September 2003. Previously restricted materials are added as they are released.

#### Scope and Content

The materials in FOIA 2003-0367-F are a selective, not necessarily all inclusive, body of documents responsive to the topic of the FOIA. Researchers should consult the archivist about related materials.

FOIA 2003-0367-F contains materials is comprised solely of Bush presidential records and consists records related to the May 31, 1989 meeting between President Bush and Prime Minister Margaret Thatcher in London, England.

FOIA 2003-0367-F consists primarily of letters, schedules, cables, notes, newspaper articles, and other printed material. Letters include outgoing thank-you letters for individuals who assisted in the planning of the Bush/Thatcher meeting and other events associated with the Bush visit to London. There are several copies of President and Mrs. Bush's schedules for their visit. Unclassified cables contain protocol information related to Mrs. Bush's lunch with Queen Elizabeth. This collection also includes notes with routine information regarding changes to Mrs. Bush's itinerary. The articles from London newspapers such as *Evening Standard*, *The Daily Telegraph*, and *The Independent* describe the various events of President and Mrs. Bush's trip. The American Embassy in London Visitors Handbook, guides to the Imperial War Museum, and a map of England are also included in this collection.

### **System of Arrangement**

Records that are responsive to this FOIA request were found in two collection areas—Bush Presidential Records: WHORM Subject Files and Bush Presidential Records: Staff and Office Files. As policy, WHORM Alphabetical Files and WHORM Subject Files are processed at the document level; whereas, Staff and Office Files are processed at the folder level, that is, individual documents are not selected and removed from a folder for processing. While this method maintains folder integrity, it frequently results in the incidental processing of documents that are not wholly responsive to the subject area.

The WHORM Subject File compiled by the White House Office of Records Management is comprised of a series of documents assigned a letter/number combination and filed in a subject category. A complete listing of the subject categories including a detailed description of each category is available in our research room and on our website at <a href="http://bushlibrary.tamu.edu/research/find/whorm/whorm.html">http://bushlibrary.tamu.edu/research/find/whorm/whorm.html</a>.

Please note that a single asterisk "\*" indicates that the category is entirely processed and open.
