#### **Extent**

501 folders

#### **Access**

Collection is open to all researchers. Access to Bush Presidential Records, Bush Vice Presidential Records, and Quayle Vice Presidential Records is governed by the Freedom of Information Act (FOIA)(5 USC 552 as amended) and the Presidential Records Act (PRA)(44 USC 22) and therefore records may be restricted in whole or in part in accordance with legal exemptions.

#### **Copyright**

Documents in this collection that were prepared by officials of the United States government as part of their official duties are in the public domain. #### **Provenance**

#### **Scope and Content**

The materials in FOIA 2004-0967-F are a selective, not necessarily all inclusive, body of documents responsive to the topic of the FOIA. Researchers should consult the archivist about related materials.

FOIA 2004-0967-F contains materials related to proposed and enacted economic assistance from the United States to Poland and Hungary (as well as Eastern Europe in a general sense). Because Hungary and Poland were the first countries to shed their communist governments and centrally planned economies in favor of representative governments and the Free Market, U.S. Government leaders (including President Bush) felt it was crucial to swiftly provide assistance to those nations which would facilitate the transition to the new forms in order to ensure political and economic freedoms were able to take root. The records in this request reflect the consensus that economic assistance was important while detailing the discussions regarding the breadth and scope of the proposed assistance.

**(Many of the records in this request have been closed due to national security restrictions. These records will be added to the request when they are released.)**

White House Office of Records Management (WHORM) Subject File categories contain correspondence; memoranda; and public remarks from the general public, Congress, heads of state, and Polish and Hungarian interest groups calling on the President and other leaders to quickly provide economic aid to Poland and Hungary as well as establishing permanent diplomatic and trade relations with those countries (including discussions regarding proposed trade legislation). Also included are memoranda and correspondence related to the establishment and proposed leadership of the Polish and Hungarian Enterprise Funds.

The Staff and Office Files contain routine memoranda and correspondence regarding the President's public/ private sector economic delegation to Poland; heads of state correspondence and talking points from discussions with President Bush and Polish and Hungarian leaders; discussion papers regarding needed economic assistance in Eastern Europe and U.S. proposals for manners of assistance; press releases, statements, and correspondence from Congressional leaders, citizens, and Polish and Hungarian interest groups regarding U.S. economic assistance to Poland and Hungary; briefing books, cables, schedules, and itineraries of POTUS trip to Poland, Hungary, and The Netherlands; correspondence between POTUS and Polish leaders regarding return of remains of Polish patriot Ignacy Jan Paderewski; toasts/ remarks from visit of President Lech Walesa in 1991; copies of proposed legislation (such as the "Polish and Hungarian Democracy Initiative of 1989") as well as Executive Branch discussion papers regarding that legislation; correspondence from people seeking participation in Polish and Hungarian Enterprise funds; copies of U.S.-Poland Business and Economic Relations Treaty; local government resolutions calling for U.S. support of democracy in Poland and Hungary; correspondence from citizens and interest groups calling for Polish participation in Two-Plus-Four talks; draft and final copies of testimony of State and Treasury officials before House and Senate committee hearings on the subject; and papers and reports on status of U.S. economic assistance to Poland and Hungary.

### **System of Arrangement**

Records that are responsive to this FOIA request were found in two collection areas—Bush Presidential Records: WHORM Subject Files and Bush Presidential Records: Staff and Office Files. As policy, Staff and Office Files are processed at the folder level, that is, individual documents are not selected and removed from a folder for processing. WHORM Subject Files are processed at the document level. While this method maintains folder integrity, it frequently results in the incidental processing of documents that are not wholly responsive to the subject area.

The WHORM Subject File compiled by the White House Office of Records Management is comprised of a series of documents assigned a letter/number combination and filed in a subject category. A complete listing of the subject categories including a detailed description of each category is available in our research room and on our website at <http://bushlibrary.tamu.edu/research/find/whorm/whorm.html>.

Please note that a single asterisk "\*" indicates that the category is entirely processed and open.
