mission to Indonesia is headed by the Ambassador of the United States, who is the personal representative of the President.

Monjo and Robert L. Barry attesting to the accuracy of their statements to the Senate; facts sheets regarding the appointment of John C. Monjo as Ambassador to Indonesia; memos regarding the recommendations and appointments of John C. Monjo and Robert L. Barry as U.S. Ambassadors to Indonesia, and about the change of nomination for Robert L. Barry from Ambassador of Yugoslavia to Ambassador of Indonesia, as well as utilized for routing correspondence; formal nominations for both John C. Monjo and Robert L. Barry as U.S. Ambassadors to Indonesia; press releases regarding: nominations to the Senate for varied positions, including those of John Cameron Monjo as Ambassador to the Islamic Republic of Pakistan; printed material, such as copies of U.S. Codes, notices concerning proper income tax reporting, and newspaper articles regarding the death of Robert and Peggy Barry's son; resumes regarding John C. Monjo; and Reports to the Committee on Foreign Relations, United States Senate, regarding John Cameron Monjo and Robert L. Barry for consideration of appointment as U.S. Ambassadors to Indonesia
