#### **Extent**

190 folders

#### **Access**

Collection is open to all researchers. Access to Bush Presidential Records, Bush Vice Presidential Records, and Quayle Vice Presidential Records is governed by the Freedom of Information Act (FOIA)(5 USC 552 as amended) and the Presidential Records Act (PRA)(44 USC 22) and therefore records may be restricted in whole or in part in accordance with legal exemptions.

#### **Copyright**

Documents in this collection that were prepared by officials of the United States government as part of their official duties are in the public domain. Researchers are advised to consult the copyright law of the United States (Title 17, USC) which governs the making of photocopies or other reproductions of copyrighted material.

#### **Provenance**

Official records of George Bush's presidency and vice presidency are housed at the George Bush Presidential Library and administered by the National Archives and Records Administration (NARA) under the provisions of the Presidential Records Act (PRA).

## Scope and Content

The materials in FOIA 2005-0052-F are a selective, not necessarily all inclusive, body of documents responsive to the topic of the FOIA. Researchers should consult the archivist about related materials.

FOIA 2005-0052-F contains materials related to U.S. support for the Mujahideen in Afghanistan during Soviet occupation of that nation (1979-1989) and relations with that nation following the Soviet military withdrawal.

**(Many of the records in this request have been closed due to national security restrictions. These records will be added to the request if and when they are released.)**

White House Office of Records Management (WHORM) Subject File categories contain letters from Afghan President Najibullah, citizens, interest groups, and U.S. legislators regarding the military, humanitarian, and refugee situations in Afghanistan and neighboring Pakistan.

The Staff and Office Files contain National Security Directives and assessments of the military situation and political atmosphere in Afghanistan both during and following Soviet occupation (many of these records originated in the Reagan administration); memoranda and reports pertaining to meetings with Mujahideen leaders and representatives of the Afghan Interim Government (AIG); the trip schedule of Secretary of State Baker to the Middle East and Europe in 1990; press releases related to the Soviet military withdrawal from Afghanistan; U.S. relations (or lack thereof) with the post-Soviet occupied Afghan government; routine correspondence between Brent Scowcroft and Congressional personnel regarding re-opening of embassy in Kabul; proposed legislation for the funding and administration of humanitarian aid to Afghanistan following the Soviet withdrawal; and papers and reports during negotiations of the Geneva Accords signed in 1988 between Afghanistan and Pakistan, including several copies of drafts and the final text.

## System of Arrangement

Records that are responsive to this FOIA request were found in two collection areas—Bush Presidential Records: WHORM Subject Files and Bush Presidential Records: Staff and Office Files. As policy, Staff and Office Files are processed at the folder level, that is, individual documents are not selected and removed from a folder for processing. WHORM Subject Files are processed at the document level. While this method maintains folder integrity, it frequently results in the incidental processing of documents that are not wholly responsive to the subject area.

The WHORM Subject File compiled by the White House Office of Records Management is comprised of a series of documents assigned a letter/number combination and filed in a subject category. A complete listing of the subject categories including a detailed description of each category is available in our research room and on our website at <http://bushlibrary.tamu.edu/research/find/whorm/whorm.html>.

Please note that a single asterisk "\*" indicates that the category is entirely processed and open.
