Provenance

Official records of George Bush's presidency and vice presidency are housed at the George Bush Presidential Library and administered by the National Archives and Records Administration (NARA) under the provisions of the Presidential Records Act (PRA).

Scope and Content

The materials in FOIA 2005-0334-F are a selective, not necessarily all inclusive, body of documents responsive to the topic of the FOIA. Researchers should consult the archivist about related materials. FOIA 2005-0334-F contains cover sheets, which route other correspondence, and correspondence between White House staff, PCAST staff, and citizens related to international science and technology cooperation, the relationship between the Department and Defense and university-based science research, the science and technology budget, and administrative issues including the establishment of PCAST, personnel selection, and PCAST member travel requests. Also included are reports on international science and technology cooperation, technology policy, the relationship of technology to the American standard of living, High Performance Computing and Communications, and science education. The proposal seeks to establish international institutes for global change research in Europe and Asia.

It should be noted that many of the documents listed here are security classified and have been closed under the restrictions of the Freedom of Information Act.

System of Arrangement

Records that are responsive to this FOIA request were found two collection areas – Bush Presidential Records: WHORM Subject Files, and Bush Presidential Records: Staff and Office Files. As policy, WHORM Alphabetical Files are processed at the document level. Staff and Office Files are processed at the folder level, that is, individual documents are not selected and removed from a folder for processing. While this method maintains folder integrity, it frequently results in the incidental processing of documents that are not wholly responsive to the subject area.

The WHORM Subject File compiled by the White House Office of Records Management is comprised of a series of documents assigned a letter/number combination and filed in a subject category. A complete listing of the subject categories including a detailed description of each category is available in our research room and on our website at <http://bushlibrary.tamu.edu/research/find/whorm/whorm.html>.

Please note that a single asterisk "*" indicates that the category is entirely processed and open.
