Access to Bush Presidential Records, Bush Vice Presidential Records, and Quayle Vice Presidential Records is governed by the Freedom of Information Act (FOIA)(5 USC 552 as amended) and the Presidential Records Act (PRA)(44 USC 22) and therefore records may be restricted in whole or in part in accordance with legal exemptions.

Copyright

Provenance

Official records of George Bush's presidency and vice presidency are housed at the George Bush Presidential Library and administered by the National Archives and Records Administration (NARA) under the provisions of the Presidential Records Act (PRA).

Scope and Content

The materials in FOIA 2005-0506-F are a selective, not necessarily all inclusive, body of documents responsive to the topic of the FOIA. Researchers should consult the archivist about related materials.

FOIA 2005-0506-F contains materials related to the U.S. relationship with the Commonwealth of the Northern Mariana Islands (CNMI). Following World War II, several Pacific island nations (including the CNMI) liberated from Japanese occupation by Allied forces were administered by the United States under the auspices of the United Nations' Trust Territory of the Pacific Islands (TTPI). In 1976, both nations entered into a closer political relationship through the negotiated Covenant to Establish a Commonwealth of the Northern Mariana Islands (CNMI) in Political Union with the United States which was fully implemented on November 3, 1986. Each nation designates special representatives of their respective interests under the Covenant. The United Nations ended the TTPI as it concerned the CNMI on December 22, 1990.

(A portion of the records in this request have been closed due to national security restrictions. These records will be added to the request if and when they are released.)

The White House Office of Records Management (WHORM) Alphabetical Files contain letters from Korean immigrants to the CNMI seeking residency/ citizenship with the United States.

The WHORM Subject File categories contain correspondence from citizens, Pacific Island advocacy groups, U.S. congressional leadership, and national leaders of the CNMI and U.S. related to issues of import including citizenship for CNMI nationals (and Congressional representation), trade, environmental concerns, fishing rights, taxation, and administrative materials pertaining to the designation of Special Representatives of the U.S. and CNMI for negotiation purposes under the Covenant. The request also contains legislative referrals, proposed legislation, and congressional testimony from Department of the Interior officials related to the topics listed above.

The Staff and Office Files contain presidential speeches and remarks to Asian/ Pacific Americans and briefing materials for the President's trip to the U.S.-Pacific Island Nations Summit in Honolulu, Hawaii in October 1990; personnel records for the nominations of designated U.S. representatives to the CNMI; and talking points related to nuclear testing in the Pacific, economic assistance, regional environmental concerns, and military relations; and requests from the CNMI Governor for funding to assist with disasters caused by typhoons. Other materials include invitations for Vice President Bush to attend the Governor's inauguration festivities.

System of Arrangement

Records that are responsive to this FOIA request were found in five collection areas—Bush Presidential Records: WHORM Subject Files; Bush Presidential Records: WHORM Alphabetical Files; Bush Presidential Records: Staff and Office Files; Bush Vice Presidential Records: WHORM Subject Files; and Bush Vice Presidential Records: Staff and Office Files. As policy, WHORM Subject and WHORM Alphabetical Files are processed at the document level; whereas, Staff and Office Files are processed at the folder level, that is, individual documents are not selected and removed from a folder for processing. While this method maintains folder integrity, it frequently results in the incidental processing of documents that are not wholly responsive to the subject area.

The WHORM Subject File compiled by the White House Office of Records Management is comprised of a series of documents assigned a letter/number combination and filed in a subject category. A complete listing of the subject categories including a detailed description of each category is available in our research room and on our website at <http://bushlibrary.tamu.edu/research/find/whorm/whorm.html>.

Please note that a single asterisk "*" indicates that the category is entirely processed and open.
