#### **Extent**

90 folders

#### **Access**

Collection is open to all researchers. Access to Bush Presidential Records, Bush Vice Presidential Records, and Quayle Vice Presidential Records is governed by the Freedom of Information Act (FOIA)(5 USC 552 as amended) and the Presidential Records Act (PRA)(44 USC 22) and therefore records may be restricted in whole or in part in accordance with legal exemptions.

#### **Copyright**

Documents in this collection that were prepared by officials of the United States government as part of their official duties are in the public domain. Researchers are advised to consult the copyright law of the United States (Title 17, USC) which governs the making of photocopies or other reproductions of copyrighted material.

#### **Provenance**

Official records of George Bush's presidency and vice presidency are housed at the George Bush Presidential Library and administered by the National Archives and Records Administration (NARA) under the provisions of the Presidential Records Act (PRA).

#### **Scope and Content**

The materials in FOIA 2005-1003-F are a systematic, and all inclusive, body of documents responsive to the topic of the FOIA. Researchers should consult the archivist about related materials.

FOIA 2005-1003-F contains materials from the National Security Council pertaining to all of the NSC meetings held during the George H. W. Bush Administration with dates ranging from February 10, 1989 to December 03, 1992. These meetings were held in a classified environment, and these records relate

to foreign policy issues that faced the administration.

The NSC Meeting Files contain correspondence, memoranda, talking points, and agendas for NSC meetings and were maintained by the National Security Council Office. The subject matters discussed during the NSC meetings pertain to foreign policy issues during the administration. Examples of subjects included are policies pertaining to Western and Eastern Europe, the Persian Gulf, South America, Nuclear Matters, and Arms Control.

### **System of Arrangement**

Records that are responsive to this FOIA request was found in one collection area—Bush Presidential Records: National Security Council H-Files: NSC Meeting Files. As policy, the NSC Meeting Files are processed at the folder level, that is, individual documents are not selected and removed from a folder for processing. While this method maintains folder integrity, it frequently results in the incidental processing of documents that are not wholly responsive to the subject area.
