Provenance

Official records of George Bush's presidency and vice presidency are housed at the George Bush Presidential Library and administered by the National Archives and Records Administration (NARA) under the provisions of the Presidential Records Act (PRA).

Scope and Content

The materials in FOIA 2005-1012-F are a selective, not necessarily all inclusive, body of documents

responsive to the topic of the FOIA. Researchers should consult the archivist about related materials.

FOIA 2005-1012-F contains materials from agencies and individuals related to the visits of Russian President Boris Yeltsin to Camp David in February 1992 and Washington, D.C. in June of that same year.

(A significant majority of the records in this request have been closed due to national security restrictions. These records will be added to the request if and when they are released.)

The White House Office of Records Management (WHORM) Alphabetical Files contain correspondence regarding a dormant RADAR site in Ukraine.

The WHORM Subject File categories contain correspondence from private interest groups, citizens, business interests, and congressional leaders raising issues to be addressed during President Bush's meetings with Yeltsin including U.S. business ventures in and economic aid to Russia, withdrawal of Russian troops from the Baltic states, arms reduction/ securing of nuclear weapons, and assisting Russian with the transition from communism to democracy. Also included are press releases and talking points memoranda related to the meetings.

The Staff and Office Files contain planning materials (cables, schedules, itineraries, remarks, etc.) associated with Yeltsin's arrival in the U.S. and reports, memoranda, and talking points related to economic aid to Russia and former Soviet republics, the transition to democracy in Russia, START [Strategic Arms Reduction Treaty] talks, trade, Global Defense, sovereign debt, disposition of former U.S.S.R. nuclear devices, unrest in Kosovo, public speeches by Yeltsin, memoranda of conversation between presidents Bush and Yeltsin, and Lend-Lease policy with Russia.

System of Arrangement

Records that are responsive to this FOIA request were found in three collection areas—Bush Presidential Records: WHORM Subject Files; Bush Presidential Records: WHORM Alphabetical Files; and Bush Presidential Records: Staff and Office Files. As policy, WHORM Subject and WHORM Alphabetical Files are processed at the document level; whereas, Staff and Office Files are processed at the folder level, that is, individual documents are not selected and removed from a folder for processing. While this method maintains folder integrity, it frequently results in the incidental processing of documents that are not wholly responsive to the subject area.

The WHORM Subject File compiled by the White House Office of Records Management is comprised of a series of documents assigned a letter/number combination and filed in a subject category. A complete listing of the subject categories including a detailed description of each category is available in our research room and on our website at <http://bushlibrary.tamu.edu/research/find/whorm/whorm.html>.

Please note that a single asterisk "*" indicates that the category is entirely processed and open.
