Official records of George Bush's presidency, his vice presidency and Dan Quayle's vice presidency are housed at the George Bush Presidential Library and administered by the National Archives and Records Administration (NARA) under the provisions of the Presidential Records Act (PRA).

Scope and Content

The materials in FOIA 2006-0668-F[1] are responsive to the topic of the FOIA.

FOIA 2006-0668-F[1] contains materials regarding the activities of the President's Foreign Intelligence Advisory Board (PFIAB). Originally created as the President's Board of Consultants on Foreign Intelligence Activities by President Dwight D. Eisenhower in 1956, this advisory board, comprised of private citizens outside government, conducts objective, independent reviews of foreign intelligence activities of the U.S. government, reports their findings and offers recommendations to the president.

President Kennedy officially changed the board's original name to its current one in 1961. Except for Jimmy Carter, who abolished the group in 1977, the advisory board has served every president since its creation.

The Bush Presidential materials contain a wide variety of documents from meeting agendas, schedules, invitations to speak at PFIAB meetings, requests for employment, correspondence from U.S. citizens and members of Congress, PFIAB staff administrative and operational functions to intelligence reports and studies as well as letters and recommendations to the president on current and future foreign intelligence concerns and topics. The materials also contain copies of newspaper and journal articles, information on PFIAB members as well as reports to Congress, including open testimony on U.S. intelligence organization to the House Permanent Select Committee on Intelligence and the Senate Select Committee on Intelligence. The Quayle Vice Presidential materials primarily consist of the PFIAB meeting that he attended and files on arms control and soviet non-compliance. Similarly, George Bush's Vice Presidential materials consist of documents from Bush's Assistant for National Security Affairs, Donald Gregg. These folders contain information on the PFIAB meetings that Bush attended as Vice President.

Much of the material responsive to this FOIA is contained in the files of the National Security Council (NSC) and, for the Vice President, the National Security Affairs Office. *Please note that although these files are listed, most of these documents are security classified and have been closed under the restrictions of the Freedom of Information Act.*

System of Arrangement

Records that are responsive to this FOIA request were found in five collection areas—Bush Presidential Records: WHORM Subject Files, Bush Presidential Records: Staff and Office Files; Bush Vice Presidential Records: Subject Files; Bush Vice Presidential Records: Staff and Office Files; and Quayle Vice Presidential Records: Staff and Office Files. As policy, the WHORM and Subject Files are processed at the document level. Staff and Office Files are processed at the folder level, that is, individual documents are not selected and removed from a folder for processing. While this method maintains folder integrity, it frequently results in the incidental processing of documents that are not wholly responsive to the subject area.

The WHORM Subject File compiled by the White House Office of Records Management and the Vice Presidential Subject Files are comprised of a series of documents assigned a letter/number combination and filed in a subject category. A complete listing of the subject categories including a detailed description of each category is available in our research room and on our website at <http://bushlibrary.tamu.edu/research/find/whorm/whorm.html>.

Please note that a single asterisk "*" indicates that the category is entirely processed and open.
