Provenance

Official records of George Bush's presidency are housed at the George Bush Presidential Library and administered by the National Archives and Records Administration (NARA) under the provisions of the Presidential Records Act (PRA).

Processed By

Staff Archivists, May 2006. Previously restricted materials are added as they are released.

Scope and Content

The materials in FOIA 2006-0701-F are a selective, not necessarily all inclusive, body of documents responsive to the topic of the FOIA. Researchers should consult the archivist about related materials. The materials associated with 2006-0701-F were generated by the National Security Council (NSC). The main documents are dated February-June 1991 and consist of materials related to an NSC policy paper (known as a National Security Review).

The White House Staff and Office Files contain cover sheets, transmittal memoranda, memoranda

concerning discussions about NSR 28, and the actual NSR itself. Virtually all of the materials have been closed for national security, however.

System of Arrangement

Records that are responsive to this FOIA request were found in one collection area--Bush Presidential Records: White House Staff and Office Files. As policy, Staff and Office files are processed at the folder level, that is, individual documents are not selected and removed from a folder for processing.

Please note that a single asterisk "*" indicates that the category is entirely processed and open.
