Access

Collection is open to all researchers. Access to Bush Presidential Records, Bush Vice Presidential Records, and Quayle Vice Presidential Records is governed by the Freedom of Information Act (FOIA)(5 USC 552 as amended) and the Presidential Records Act (PRA)(44 USC 22) and therefore records may be restricted in whole or in part in accordance with legal exemptions.

Copyright

Documents in this collection that were prepared by officials of the United States government as part of their official duties are in the public domain. Researchers are advised to consult the copyright law of the United States (Title 17, USC) which governs the making of photocopies or other reproductions of copyrighted material.

Provenance

Official records of George Bush's presidency and vice presidency are housed at the George Bush Presidential Library and administered by the National Archives and Records Administration (NARA) under the provisions of the Presidential Records Act (PRA).

Scope and Content

The materials in FOIA 2007-0142-F are a selective, not necessarily all inclusive, body of documents responsive to the topic of the FOIA. Researchers should consult the archivist about related materials.

FOIA 2007-0142-F consists of materials related to Khosro Moghadam or his father, Lt. General

Moghaddam, Aide-de Camp to His Imperial Majesty/The Shah of Iran. Lt. General Nasser Moghaddam also served the Shah as the Chief of Intelligence of the Military Forces and as head of SAVAK, the domestic security and intelligence service of Iran. Lt. General Moghaddam was murdered by the Khomeni Government in 1979 and his family was given asylum in the United States.

The White House Office of Records Management (WHORM) Alphabetical File category contains letters and a telegram. The letters are between the White House and Mr. Khosro Moghadam, a copy of a general letter from Eugene Tighe, Lt. General, USAF (Ret), Director of the Defense Intelligence Agency (DIA), and letters between Lt. General Moghaddam and Lt. General Eugene Tighe.

System of Arrangement Records that are responsive to this FOIA request were found in one collection area—Bush Presidential Records: WHORM Alphabetical Files. WHORM Subject and WHORM Alphabetical Files are processed at the document level. While this method maintains folder integrity, it frequently results in the incidental processing of documents that are not wholly responsive to the subject area.
