Scope and Content

The materials in FOIA 2007-0672-F are a selective, not necessarily all inclusive, body of documents responsive to the topic of the FOIA. Researchers should consult the archivist about related materials.

FOIA 2007-0672-F consists of one staff and office file from the White House Office of Public Liaison and contains a 2 page outline that provides an agenda, itinerary, and participants list for a White House meeting with environmentalists about the acid rain provisions of the Clean Air Bill held on August 2, 1989.

System of Arrangement

Records that are responsive to this FOIA request were found in one collection area—Bush Presidential Records. Staff and Office Files are processed at the folder level, that is, individual documents are not selected and removed from a folder for processing. While this method maintains folder integrity, it frequently results in the incidental processing of documents that are not wholly responsive to the subject area.
