#### **Extent**

48 folders

#### **Access**

Collection is open to all researchers. Access to Bush Presidential Records is governed by the Freedom of Information Act (FOIA)(5 USC 552 as amended) and the Presidential Records Act (PRA)(44 USC 22) and therefore records may be restricted in whole or in part in accordance with legal exemptions.

#### **Copyright**

Documents in this collection that were prepared by officials of the United States government as part of their official duties are in the public domain. Researchers are advised to consult the copyright law of the United States (Title 17, USC) which governs the making of photocopies or other reproductions of copyrighted material.

#### **Provenance**

Official records of George Bush's presidency are housed at the George Bush Presidential Library and administered by the National Archives and Records Administration (NARA) under the provisions of the Presidential Records Act (PRA).

#### **Processed By**

#### **Related Collections**

#### **Scope and Content**

The materials in FOIA 2007-0431-F are a selective, not necessarily all inclusive, body of documents responsive to the topic of the FOIA. Researchers should consult the archivist about related materials. FOIA 2008-0431-F contains material related to Afghanistan.

Material responsive to this FOIA consists of materials related to U.S. relations with Afghanistan. The Staff and Office Files contain memoranda and reports pertaining to meetings of George Bush, both as President and Vice President, and of Vice President Quayle, with various Afghan leaders and representatives; talking points for meetings with Afghan Resistance Leaders; schedule proposals for requested meetings and photo ops.

It should be noted that a significant number of the documents listed here are security classified and have been closed under the restrictions of the Freedom of Information Act.

### **System of Arrangement**

Records that are responsive to this FOIA request were found in three areas: Bush Presidential Records: Staff and Office Files, Bush Vice Presidential Records: Staff and Office Files, and Quayle Vice Presidential Records: Staff and Office Files. Staff and Office Files are processed at the folder level, that is, individual documents are not selected and removed from a folder for processing. While this method maintains folder integrity, it frequently results in the incidental processing of documents that are not wholly responsive to the subject area. Staff and Office Files are arranged alphabetically by office.
