Scope and Content

The materials in FOIA 2010-1632-S are a systematic, and all inclusive, body of documents responsive to the topic of the FOIA. Researchers should consult the archivist about related materials.

FOIA 2010-1632-S contains materials from agencies and individuals including the United States Information Agency (USIA) which is responsible for the US government's overseas information and cultural programs; The Department of State; and The Department of Energy.

The National Security Council NSD Files contain Presidential Directives, National Security Directives, correspondence, memoranda, and publications maintained by individual staff members of the National Security Council Office. The Bush Administration issued seventy-nine National Security Directives between 1989 and 1993. Unlike National Security Reviews, National Security Directives address specific issues concerning national security and U.S. foreign policy.

System of Arrangement

Records that are responsive to this FOIA request are found in one collection area—Bush Presidential Records: National Security Council H-Files—NSD Files. Staff and Office Files are processed at the folder level, that is, individual documents are not selected and removed from a folder for processing. While this method maintains folder integrity, it frequently results in the incidental processing of documents that are not wholly responsive to the subject area.
