Scope and Content

The materials in 2011-1278-S are a systematically processed body of documents from the White House Office of Records Management (WHORM) Subject File category CO001-05. These records consist of correspondence regarding changes in Central and Eastern Europe and the European Community; government employees interested in positions dealing with new democracies in Eastern Europe; Congressional concerns about economic issues in/with Europe; and constituent concerns over the unrest in Yugoslavia. Also included are organizational charts of the United States Mission to the European Communities; anecdotal reports from constituents on U.S.-Europe relations; pamphlets on Europe in

1992; statements of testimony presented to Congress by the private sector; magazine and newspaper articles regarding the Soviet Union and Eastern Europe; constituent-written papers and reports on the situation in Eastern Europe with recommendations for U.S. policy; memos, letters and reports on the Support for Eastern European Democracy Act of 1991; and Presidential speeches given during visits of European leaders.

Records that are responsive to this request were found in Bush Presidential Records: WHORM Subject Files.

The WHORM Subject File compiled by the White House Office of Records Management is comprised of a series of documents assigned a letter/number combination and filed in a subject category.
