#### **Scope and Content**

The materials in 2011-1313-S are a systematically processed body of documents from the White House Office of Records Management (WHORM) Subject File category CO034-02.

This is a secondary subject category, containing Congressional and constituent correspondence, printed material, reports, and statements. The documents discuss a variety of issues relating to the People's Republic of China, such as the events in Tiananmen Square, immigrant status for Chinese, Most Favored Nation Status, joint US-China business ventures, economic sanctions, family planning, political prisoners,

and human rights concerns in China and Tibet.

**System of Arrangement**

Records that are responsive to this request were found in Bush Presidential Records: WHORM Subject Files. The WHORM Subject File compiled by the White House Office of Records Management is comprised of a series of documents assigned a letter/number combination and filed in a subject category.
