#### **Extent**

#### **Access**

Collection is open to all researchers. Access to Bush Presidential Records, Bush Vice Presidential Records, and Quayle Vice Presidential Records is governed by the Freedom of Information Act (FOIA)(5 USC 552 as amended) and the Presidential Records Act (PRA)(44 USC 22) and therefore records may be restricted in whole or in part in accordance with legal exemptions.

#### **Scope and Content**

The materials in FOIA 2011-2116-F are a selective, not necessarily all inclusive, body of documents responsive to the topic of the FOIA. Researchers should consult the archivist about related materials.

FOIA 2011-2116-F contains materials from agencies and individuals including the White House, U.S. Departments of State and Defense, and the United States Coast Guard related to immigration from Central America and the Caribbean, with the bulk of materials relating to the mass seaborne exodus of Haitian "Boat People".

The WHORM Subject File categories contain correspondence from Congress, citizens, and interest groups requesting that the President take action against the repressive government in Haiti and/ or provide aid and asylum to refugees, copies of newspaper articles related to events in Haiti, and memoranda and reports between the Bush Administration and Congress regarding foreign aid and relief programs for Haiti.

The Staff and Office Files contain correspondence from Congress, citizens, and interest groups requesting that the President take action against the repressive government in Haiti and/ or provide aid and asylum to refugees, copies of newspaper articles related to events in Haiti, and memoranda and reports between the Bush Administration and Congress regarding foreign aid and relief programs for Haiti. Additional records include Statements of Administration Policy regarding Bush Administration views on proposed legislation regarding immigration and foreign aid to Haiti; press statements and releases; reports regarding deportation, asylum policies, and status of refugees at Guantanamo Bay, Cuba. These records also contain memoranda regarding Administration policy decisions towards Haiti and the Boat People as well as reports regarding U.S. Coast Guard interdictions.

**(A portion of the records in this request have been closed due to national security restrictions. These records will be added to the request if and when they are released.)**

Records that are responsive to this FOIA request were found in three collection areas—Bush Presidential Records: WHORM Subject Files; Bush Presidential Records: Staff and Office Files and Bush Vice Presidential Records: Staff and Office Files. As policy, WHORM Subject Files are processed at the document level. Staff and Office Files are processed at the folder level, that is, individual documents are not selected and removed from a folder for processing. While this method maintains folder integrity, it frequently results in the incidental processing of documents that are not wholly responsive to the subject area.

The WHORM Subject File compiled by the White House Office of Records Management is comprised of a series of documents assigned a letter/number combination and filed in a subject category. A complete listing of the subject categories including a detailed description of each category is available in our research room and on our website at <http://bushlibrary.tamu.edu/research/find/whorm/whorm.html>.

Please note that a single asterisk "\*" indicates that the category is entirely processed and open.
