Scope and Content

The materials in FOIA 2012-1098-F are a selective, not necessarily all inclusive, body of Bush Presidential records related to US-China Business Relations and Most Favored Nation (MFN) Status for China.

FOIA 2012-1098-F contains correspondence, papers and reports, press releases, printed material, and speeches which address bilateral issues such as Most Favored Nation (MFN) Status and general trade relations, economic sanctions, immigration, and human rights.

The White House Office of Records Management (WHORM) Files contain correspondence, printed material, and reports from the Bush administration, Congress, and the general public concerning economic and diplomatic relations with China.

The Staff and Office Files contain correspondence, statements, reports, press releases, and printed material from the Bush Administration, Congress, local and state government, private businesses and organizations, and the general public. These materials express support for or opposition to the extension of MFN status and immigration of China nationals, address economic issues such as post-Tiananmen Square sanctions and trade, and discuss bilateral issues such as Peace Corps China and Voice of America broadcasts to China.

It should be noted that a significant number of the documents listed here are security classified and have been closed under the restrictions of the Freedom of Information Act.

System of Arrangement

Records that are responsive to this FOIA request were found in three collection areas—Bush Presidential Records: WHORM Alphabetical Files; Bush Presidential Records: WHORM Subject Files; and Bush Presidential Records: Staff and Office Files. As policy, WHORM Alphabetical Files and WHORM Subject Files are processed at the document level. Staff and Office Files are processed at the folder level, that is, individual documents are not selected and removed from a folder for processing. While this method maintains folder integrity, it frequently results in the incidental processing of documents that are not wholly responsive to the subject area.

The WHORM Subject File compiled by the White House Office of Records Management is comprised of a series of documents assigned a letter/number combination and filed in a subject category. A complete listing of the subject categories including a detailed description of each category is available in our research room and on our website at <http://bushlibrary.tamu.edu/research/find/whorm/whorm.html>.

Please note that a single asterisk "*" indicates that the category is entirely processed and open.
