Collection is open to all researchers. Access to Bush Presidential Records, Bush Vice Presidential Records, and Quayle Vice Presidential Records is governed by the Freedom of Information Act (FOIA)(5 USC 552 as amended) and the Presidential Records Act (PRA)(44 USC 22) and therefore records may be restricted in whole or in part in accordance with legal exemptions.

Copyright

Documents in this collection that were prepared by officials of the United States government as part of their official duties are in the public domain. Researchers are advised to consult the copyright law of the United States (Title 17, USC) which governs the making of photocopies or other reproductions of copyrighted material.

Provenance

Official records of George Bush's presidency and vice presidency are housed at the George Bush Presidential Library and administered by the National Archives and Records Administration (NARA) under the provisions of the Presidential Records Act (PRA).

Processed By

Staff Archivists, July 2012. Previously restricted materials are added as they are released.

Scope and Content

The materials in FOIA 2012-2216-F are a selective, not necessarily all inclusive, body of documents responsive to the topic of the FOIA. Researchers should consult the archivist about related materials.

At this time the majority of the records in this request are security classified and have been closed under the restrictions of the Freedom of Information Act. The open records consist of memoranda, lists, papers, press releases, and printed material maintained by individual staff members and offices. The

memoranda contain standard memos regarding requests for appointments, proposed schedules, and meetings with Japanese officials. Lists include dinner guest list and meeting participants lists. Included in the material is a research paper on the topic of Japanese foreign aid by the Director of the Kyoto Center for Japanese Studies. Press releases relate to the appointment of Japan's Ambassador to the U.S. and transcript of the Ambassador's speech to the Japan-America Society. Printed material includes news articles regarding U.S.-Japan relations, as well as the Department of State's Office of Public Communications July 1980 edition of Background Notes publication on Japan.

System of Arrangement

Records that are responsive to this FOIA request were found in three collection areas—Bush Presidential Records: Staff and Office Files; Bush Vice Presidential Records: Staff and Office Files; Quayle Vice Presidential Records: Staff and Office Files. As policy, Staff and Office Files are processed at the folder level, that is, individual documents are not selected and removed from a folder for processing. While this method maintains folder integrity, it frequently results in the incidental processing of documents that are not wholly responsive to the subject area.
