Provenance

Official records of George Bush's presidency and vice presidency are housed at the George Bush Presidential Library and administered by the National Archives and Records Administration (NARA) under the provisions of the Presidential Records Act (PRA).

Processed By

Staff Archivists, March 2013. Previously restricted materials are added as they are released.

System of Arrangement

Records that are responsive to this FOIA request were found in one collection area—Bush Presidential Records: Staff and Office Files. Staff and Office Files are processed at the folder level, that is, individual documents are not selected and removed from a folder for processing. While this method maintains folder integrity, it frequently results in the incidental processing of documents that are not wholly responsive to the subject area.

Scope and Content

The materials in FOIA 2012-3129-S are a selective, not necessarily all inclusive, body of documents responsive to the topic of the FOIA. Researchers should consult the archivist about related materials.

FOIA 2012-3129-S contains materials from the National Security Council and individuals including G. Philip Hughes. These records pertain to the period of time when Ambassador Hughes served as Executive Secretary to the National Security Council 1989–1990. Prior to serving in the National Security Council, Ambassador Hughes served as Assistant Secretary for Export Enforcement in The Department of Commerce 1988–1989. In 1990 G. Philip Hughes was appointed Ambassador to Barbados, Dominica, St. Lucia, and St. Vincent and the Grenadines. Ambassador G. Philip Hughes was born September 7, 1953 in Dayton Ohio. He received a B.A. in Political Science at the University of Dayton in 1973. Ambassador Hughes received an A.M from Fletcher School of Law in 1974 and a M.A.L.D. from Harvard in 1975. Ambassador Hughes served as Assistant Director for Intelligence Policy in the Office of the Secretary of Defense 1981–1985, Deputy Assistant to the Vice President for National Security Affairs 1985–1986, Director for Latin American Affairs, National Security Council 1986–1988, and Deputy Assistant Secretary for Politico-Military Affairs, Department of State 1988–1989.

The Staff and Office Files contain correspondence, memoranda, and publications maintained by the National Security Council and G. Philip Hughes.
