Provenance

Official records of George Bush's presidency are housed at the George Bush Presidential Library and administered by the National Archives and Records Administration (NARA) under the provisions of the Presidential Records Act (PRA).

Processed By

Scope and Content

The materials in FOIA 2012-3139-S are a systematically processed body of documents regarding the African Affairs Directorate, including the Subject [Countries] Files and State Visit Files of John M Ordway. The documents to be opened include memoranda, correspondence, press releases, lists, and memcons. Memoranda consists of routine transmittal and cover memos, schedule proposals for official working visits of foreign leaders, foreign travel approval for NSC staff members, proposed talking points for photo-ops, and draft arrival and departure statements. Correspondence consists of public and Congressional mail expressing concern and opinions on topics such as the situation in Angola, humanitarian relief in Ethiopia, Apartheid, and the lifting of sanctions in South Africa. Also included are invitations to the President and various White House staff members to attend African aid fundraisers. Press releases include arrival and

departure statements given by the President on the occasion of visiting Heads of State. Lists consist of meeting participants. Memcons contain unclassified memorandum of conversation between the President and foreign leaders.

System of Arrangement

Records that are responsive to this request were found in one collection area—Bush Presidential Records: Staff and Office Files. As policy, WHORM Alphabetical Files and WHORM Subject Files are processed at the document level. Staff and Office Files are processed at the folder level, that is, individual documents are not selected and removed from a folder for processing. While this method maintains folder integrity, it frequently results in the incidental processing of documents that are not wholly responsive to the subject area.
