Official records of George Bush's presidency are housed at the George Bush Presidential Library and administered by the National Archives and Records Administration (NARA) under the provisions of the Presidential Records Act (PRA).

Processed By

Scope and Content

The materials in FOIA 2012-3140-S are a systematically processed body of documents regarding the files of Jerry W. Leach, Director of International Economic Affairs at the National Security Council.

The documents to be opened include memoranda, correspondence, papers, printed material, press releases, talking points, and presidential remarks. Memoranda consists of transmittal memos, scheduling requests, meeting agendas, draft executive orders, and routine inter-staff memos concerning issues such as whaling moratorium, global warming, and hazardous waste export. Correspondence includes public and Congressional letters on such topics as saving the rainforest, global warming, the relationship between energy and environmental policies, and an invitation for US to attend the Bergen Conference on environmentally-sound and sustainable development. Papers include environmental initiatives for Eastern Europe; a summary of current knowledge about global climate change; a working paper on the Arctic ecosystem, and a draft report to Congress on the potential effects of global climate change on the U.S.

by the Environmental Protection Agency (EPA). Printed material consists of news articles concerning environment topics such as the greenhouse effect, global warming, pollution, clean air, acid rain, and whale conservation. Press releases include World Trade Week 1989, fact sheet on presidential decision on hazardous waste export, fact sheet on President Bush's Clean Air Plan, and press briefing by EPA Administrator William Reilly and Energy Secretary Admiral James Watkins. Talking points include action to protect the environment and the President's conference on the environment. Presidential remarks are in regards to the announcement of the Clean Air Act Amendment, statement on World Environment Day, and a message for the Sundance Institute conference on global warming.

System of Arrangement

Records that are responsive to this request were found in one collection area—Bush Presidential Records: Staff and Office Files. As policy, WHORM Alphabetical Files and WHORM Subject Files are processed at the document level. Staff and Office Files are processed at the folder level, that is, individual documents are not selected and removed from a folder for processing. While this method maintains folder integrity, it frequently results in the incidental processing of documents that are not wholly responsive to the subject area.
