#### **Access**

Collection is open to all researchers. Access to Bush Presidential Records, Bush Vice Presidential Records, and Quayle Vice Presidential Records is governed by the Freedom of Information Act (FOIA)(5 USC 552 as amended) and the Presidential Records Act (PRA)(44 USC 22) and therefore records may be restricted in whole or in part in accordance with legal exemptions.

#### **Copyright**

Documents in this collection that were prepared by officials of the United States government as part of their official duties are in the public domain. #### **Provenance**

Official records of George Bush's presidency and vice presidency are housed at the George Bush Presidential Library and administered by the National Archives and Records Administration (NARA) under the provisions of the Presidential Records Act (PRA).

#### **Processed By**

Staff Archivists, March 2013. Previously restricted materials are added as they are released.

#### **System of Arrangement**

Records that are responsive to this FOIA request were found in the Quayle Vice Presidential Records: Staff and Office Files. As policy, Staff and Office Files are processed at the folder level, that is, individual documents are not selected and removed from a folder for processing. While this method maintains folder integrity, it frequently results in the incidental processing of documents that are not wholly responsive to the subject area.

## Scope and Content

The materials in FOIA 2013-0362-S [2] are the documents maintained by the National Security Affairs Office as Country Files.

These records consist of correspondence, press releases, printed material, and reports organized by country. The correspondence includes social exchanges between Vice President Quayle and foreign dignitaries (thank you letters, congratulatory messages, invitations, and condolences), thank you and congratulatory messages from Vice President Quayle to US Ambassadors, and letters from private citizens and organization discussing issues such as humanitarian aid and international trade. Press releases contain statements and speeches by Vice President Quayle on domestic and international issues, White House statements on issues such as trade and foreign aid, and statements from American and foreign private companies. Printed material include papers, articles, and reports by private citizens and organizations addressing international issues, such as German Reunification, Middle East Peace Process, economic and political reform in the former Soviet Union, and US economic relations with various countries. Reports contain unclassified White House reports to Congress and a working paper from a private organization on Central America-US cooperation.
