Provenance

Official records of George Bush's presidency and vice presidency are housed at the George Bush Presidential Library and administered by the National Archives and Records Administration (NARA) under the provisions of the Presidential Records Act (PRA).

Processed By

Staff Archivists, May 2014. Previously restricted materials are added as they are released.

System of Arrangement

Records that are responsive to this FOIA request were found in one collection areas—Bush Vice Presidential Records. Staff and Office Files are processed at the folder level, that is, individual documents are not selected and removed from a folder for processing. While this method maintains folder integrity, it frequently results in the incidental processing of documents that are not wholly responsive to the subject area.

Scope and Content

The materials in FOIA 2013-1216-S are a selective, not necessarily all inclusive, body of documents responsive to the topic of the FOIA. Researchers should consult the archivist about related materials.

FOIA 2013-1216-S contains materials from the files of John G. Keller with the Advance Office, whose personnel oversaw the arrangements for the Vice President's travel to foreign countries.

The Staff and Office Files contain draft and summary schedules, including departure, flight and arrival times, official and traveling party lists, visa application paperwork, travel vouchers, copies of airline tickets as well as telephone and contact lists for the American State Department personnel occupying the various foreign embassies where the Vice President would visit. Additionally, country background information, such as differences in time zones, currency conversion charts, papers on religious and customary practices; notes on gifts, restaurants, shopping; country and city maps; several government publications produced the Bureau of Public Affairs, Department of State; correspondence from U.S. citizens and Congressmen requesting to accompany the Vice President, and brief biographies on the U.S. Ambassador and key embassy personnel to familiarize the Vice President.
