#### **Extent**

22 folders

#### **Access**

Collection is open to all researchers. Access to Bush Presidential Records, Bush Vice Presidential Records, and Quayle Vice Presidential Records is governed by the Freedom of Information Act (FOIA)(5 USC 552 as amended) and the Presidential Records Act (PRA)(44 USC 22) and therefore records may be restricted in whole or in part in accordance with legal exemptions.

## Copyright

Documents in this collection that were prepared by officials of the United States government as part of their official duties are in the public domain. Researchers are advised to consult the copyright law of the United States (Title 17, USC) which governs the making of photocopies or other reproductions of copyrighted material.

### **Provenance**

Official records of George Bush's presidency and vice presidency are housed at the George Bush Presidential Library and administered by the National Archives and Records Administration (NARA) under the provisions of the Presidential Records Act (PRA).

#### **Processed By**

Staff Archivists, May 2014. Previously restricted materials are added as they are released.

#### **System of Arrangement**

Records that are responsive to this FOIA request were found in four collection areas—Bush Presidential Records: WHORM Subject Files; Bush Presidential Records: Staff and Office Files; Bush Vice Presidential Records: Staff and Office Files. As policy, WHORM Alphabetical Files and WHORM Subject Files are processed at the document level. Staff and Office Files are processed at the folder level, that is, individual documents are not selected and removed from a

folder for processing. While this method maintains folder integrity, it frequently results in the incidental processing of documents that are not wholly responsive to the subject area.

The WHORM Subject File compiled by the White House Office of Records Management is comprised of a series of documents assigned a letter/number combination and filed in a subject category. A complete listing of the subject categories including a detailed description of each category is available in our research room and on our website at <a href="http://bushlibrary.tamu.edu/research/find/whorm/whorm.html">http://bushlibrary.tamu.edu/research/find/whorm/whorm.html</a>.

Please note that a single asterisk "\*" indicates that the category is entirely processed and open.

#### **Scope and Content**

The materials in FOIA 2014-0695-F are a selective, not necessarily all inclusive, body of documents responsive to the topic of the FOIA. Researchers should consult the archivist about related materials.

FOIA 2014-0695-F contains materials relevant to the contact between George Bush and HRH Prince Charles.

The Bush Presidential Records: WHORM Subject Files contain information regarding gifts exchanged and some limited correspondence between the two men while the Staff and Office files detail various social events held in honor of Prince Charles and when appropriate, Princess Diana. These materials detail protocol, schedules, menu choices, etc.

The Bush Vice Presidential Records: Subject Files contain correspondence regarding the State Dinner held for HRH Prince of Wales and HRH the Princess of Wales. The Staff and Office Files again detail social events conducted during George Bush's tenure as Vice President and includes a program from the National Cathedral Service with HRH, talking points for a toast given in his honor, seating arrangements, schedules, checklists, blank building diagrams, etc.
