Processed By

System of Arrangement

Records that are responsive to this systematic project were found in one collection area—Bush Presidential Records: Staff and Office Files. Staff and Office Files are processed at the folder level, that is, individual documents are not selected and removed from a folder for processing. While this method maintains folder integrity, it frequently results in the incidental processing of documents that are not wholly responsive to the subject area.

Scope and Content

The materials in Case Number 2014-0903-S are a systematically processed body of documents from the files of Colonel Jeffrey B. Jones. Jones acted as Director for Defense Policy and Arms Control for the National Security Council from 1991–93.

CASE NUMBER 2014-0903-S contains records consisting of correspondence, press releases, printed material, reports, and statements.

The Staff and Office Files contain records which address military and defense issues such as appropriations, base closures, DOD budget, defense management, military base closures and military land reform, NATO/UN peacekeeping, procurement, veterans services, and women in combat.

It should be noted that a significant number of the documents listed here are security classified and have been closed under the restrictions of the Freedom of Information Act.
