Provenance

Official records of George Bush's presidency and vice presidency are housed at the George Bush Presidential Library and administered by the National Archives and Records Administration (NARA) under the provisions of the Presidential Records Act (PRA).

Processed By

Staff Archivists, September 2018. Previously restricted materials are added as they are released.

System of Arrangement

Records that are responsive to this FOIA request were found in three collection areas—Bush Presidential Records: WHORM Subject Files; Bush Presidential Records: Staff and Office Files; and Bush Vice Presidential Records: WHORM Subject Files. As policy, WHORM Alphabetical Files and WHORM Subject Files are processed at the document level. Staff and Office Files are processed at the folder level, that is, individual documents are not selected and removed from a folder for processing. While this method

maintains folder integrity, it frequently results in the incidental processing of documents that are not wholly responsive to the subject area.

The WHORM Subject File compiled by the White House Office of Records Management is comprised of a series of documents assigned a letter/number combination and filed in a subject category. A complete listing of the subject categories including a detailed description of each category is available in our research room and on our website at <http://bushlibrary.tamu.edu/research/find/whorm/whorm.html>.

Scope and Content

The materials in FOIA 2015-0655-F are a selective, not necessarily all inclusive, body of documents responsive to the topic of the FOIA. Researchers should consult the archivist about related materials.

FOIA 2015-0655-F contains materials related to transportation issues during Bush's Vice Presidential and Presidential terms of office.

The Bush Presidential WHORM Subject File category contains White House Correspondence Tracking Worksheets, letters and biographies. These documents pertain to the appointments of John W. Snow and John G. Roach to the National Commission on Intermodal Transportation.

The Bush Presidential Staff and Office Files contain memos, questionnaires, clearance requests, biographies, personal data statements, news releases and guidance related to appointments of personnel to the National Commission on Intermodal Transportation. Information on enrolled bills describe the purpose of legislation addressing highway funding, programs, safety, and airport authorities. Presidential statements and press releases announce approval of this legislation in addition to key legal features.

The Bush Vice Presidential WHORM Subject Files contain Vice Presidential Correspondence Tracking Worksheets, letters, Scheduling File Tracking Sheets, Vice Presidential Activity memos, scheduling requests, invitations extended to Vice President Bush and replies, a transportation conference schedule, and an exhibit program.
