Official records of George Bush's presidency and vice presidency are housed at the George Bush Presidential Library and administered by the National Archives and Records Administration (NARA) under the provisions of the Presidential Records Act (PRA).

Processed By

Staff Archivists, September 2016. Previously restricted materials are added as they are released.

System of Arrangement

Records that are responsive to this FOIA request were found in two collection areas—Bush Presidential Records: WHORM Subject Files; and Bush Presidential Records: Staff and Office Files. As policy, WHORM Subject Files are processed at the document level. Staff and Office Files are processed at the folder level; that is, individual documents are not selected and removed from a folder for processing. While this

method maintains folder integrity, it frequently results in the incidental processing of documents that are not wholly responsive to the subject area.

The WHORM Subject File compiled by the White House Office of Records Management is comprised of a series of documents assigned a letter/number combination and filed in a subject category. A complete listing of the subject categories including a detailed description of each category is available in our research room and on our website at <http://bushlibrary.tamu.edu/research/find/whorm/whorm.html>.

Please note that a single asterisk "*" indicates that the category is entirely processed and open.

Scope and Content

The materials in FOIA 2016-2675-F are a selective, not necessarily all inclusive, body of documents responsive to the topic of the FOIA. Researchers should consult the archivist about related materials.

FOIA 2016-2675-F contains materials from agencies and individuals including Bush Quayle '92, the United States Department of Justice, and the White House Offices of Presidential Advance, Press, and Speechwriting. These records relate to anti-crime events attended by President Bush on September 28, 1992 in St. Louis, Missouri, and Dallas, Texas. The event at St. Francis de Sales Church in the Fox Park neighborhood of St. Louis highlighted a community-based solution to crime, while the East Dallas Renaissance Project involved a partnership between federal, state, city, and neighborhood groups.

The WHORM Subject File categories contain speeches for the September 28, 1992 events, advocating crime prevention strategies employed in these localities.

The Staff and Office Files contain notes, forms, cover sheets, letters, newspaper articles, memos, diagrams, proposals, schedules, press releases, speeches, and speech drafts. The records of the White House Press Office contain press releases covering the events, while the White House Office of Speechwriting materials include speech drafts and comments on speeches. The White House Office of Public Liaison's Greg Fitch Files are concerned with preparations for the events, including memos, diagrams, proposals, and schedules prepared by the White House Office of Presidential Advance, and outlining possible benefits to the Bush Quayle '92 campaign. A letter from the United States Department of Justice urges an alternative proposal.
