Access

Collection is open to all researchers. Access to Bush Presidential Records, Bush Vice Presidential Records, and Quayle Vice Presidential Records is governed by the Freedom of Information Act (FOIA)(5 USC 552 as amended) and the Presidential Records Act (PRA)(44 USC 22) and therefore records may be restricted in whole or in part in accordance with legal exemptions.

Copyright

Researchers are advised to consult the copyright law of the United States (Title 17, USC) which governs the making of photocopies or other reproductions of copyrighted material.

Provenance

Official records of George Bush's presidency and vice presidency are housed at the George Bush Presidential Library and administered by the National Archives and Records Administration (NARA) under the provisions of the Presidential Records Act (PRA).

Processed By

Staff Archivists, May 2017. Previously restricted materials are added as they are released.

System of Arrangement

EXAMPLE:

Records that are responsive to this FOIA request were found in three collection areas—Bush Presidential Records: WHORM Alphabetical Files; Bush Presidential Records: WHORM Subject Files; and Bush Presidential Records: Staff and Office Files. As policy, WHORM Alphabetical Files and WHORM Subject

Files are processed at the document level. Staff and Office Files are processed at the folder level, that is, individual documents are not selected and removed from a folder for processing. While this method maintains folder integrity, it frequently results in the incidental processing of documents that are not wholly responsive to the subject area.

The WHORM Subject File compiled by the White House Office of Records Management is comprised of a series of documents assigned a letter/number combination and filed in a subject category. A complete listing of the subject categories including a detailed description of each category is available in our research room and on our website at <http://bushlibrary.tamu.edu/research/find/whorm/whorm.html>.

Please note that a single asterisk "*" indicates that the category is entirely processed and open.

FOIA 2016-2776-F contains materials from agencies and individuals concerning the appointment and resignations of several US Inspectors General

The White House Office of Records Management (WHORM) Alphabetical File contains a brief biography of John C. Martin, Inspector General for the Environmental Protection Agency.

The WHORM Subject File categories contain correspondence, forms, press releases and reports from the general public, Congress, and the Bush administration. Many of the WHORM categories deal with specific federal agencies. There are memos from Chase Untermeyer to President Bush for approval of personnel appointments. There are also press releases announcing the appointments of new officials. Letters from the public and Congress concerning their approval or disapproval of potential appointees, as well as letters of resignation from certain IGs.

The Staff and Office Files contain correspondence, memoranda, and publications maintained by individual staff members and offices. The Counsel's Office and Personnel Office files contain forms and correspondence concerning the appointment of several Inspectors general positions. There are also additional copies of press releases for personnel announcements.
