System of Arrangement

Records for this systematic project were found in the following collection area: Bush Presidential Records: Staff and Office Files. As policy, Staff and Office Files are processed at the folder level, that is, individual documents are not selected and removed from a folder for processing. While this method maintains folder integrity, it frequently results in the incidental processing of documents that are not wholly responsive to the subject area.

Scope and Content

The materials in 2017-0341-S are a systematically processed body of documents created and maintained by J. French Hill, Council of Economic Advisers. These records discuss the economic implications of various domestic issues (e.g. defense spending, inflation, employment, health care, regulation) and international issues (e.g. trade, environmental protection).

The Staff and Office Files contain correspondence, meeting notes, press releases, printed material, remarks, and reports. Internal CEA correspondence comments on studies, reports, and proposed regulations from various agencies and organizes administrative issues, such as travel and meeting. Correspondence with other government agencies, Congress, and private individuals and organizations addresses economic issues such as trade policy, anti-trust regulations, defense spending, education, export restraints, and tariff agreements.

Handwritten notes from meetings of the Economic Policy Council discuss international economic issues such as trade and the environment, and domestic economic issues such as telecommunications, agriculture, transportation, economic recovery, bank regulations, health care, and education.

Press releases include fact sheets on topics such as defense adjustment assistance, federal relief assistance, customs audit, and other domestic and international economic issues. Printed material consists of newspaper and magazine clippings on mergers, military spending, foreign aid, international trade, and customs. Remarks from various executive branch officials address issues such as antitrust enforcements, international competition, maritime policy, and international trade. Reports discuss proposed legislation and regulations and other economic issues such as maritime policy, international trade, and the Tokyo stock market crash.

These records are divided into two series:

1. PCG Group EPC Meetings Files: 5 boxes, arranged alphabetically. Meeting folders whose title begins with "PCG [Policy Coordinating Group]" are arranged chronologically.
