Access to Bush Presidential Records, Bush Vice Presidential Records, and Quayle Vice Presidential Records is governed by the Freedom of Information Act (FOIA)(5 USC 552 as amended) and the Presidential Records Act (PRA)(44 USC 22) and therefore records may be restricted in whole or in part in accordance with legal exemptions.

### Copyright

Documents in this collection that were prepared by officials of the United States government as part of their official duties are in the public domain. ### Provenance

Official records of George Bush's presidency and vice presidency are housed at the George Bush Presidential Library and administered by the National Archives and Records Administration (NARA) under the provisions of the Presidential Records Act (PRA).

### Processed By

### System of Arrangement

Records for this systematic project were found in the following collection area: Bush Presidential Records: Staff and Office Files. As policy, Staff and Office Files are processed at the folder level, that is, individual documents are not selected and removed from a folder for processing. While this method maintains folder integrity, it frequently results in the incidental processing of documents that are not wholly responsive to the subject area.

## Scope and Content

The materials in 2017–0354 are a systematically processed body of documents created and maintained by Gary Saxonhouse, Council of Economic Advisers.

The Staff and Office Files contain correspondence, press releases, printed material, and reports. Internal correspondence provides meeting schedules. Correspondence from executive branch agencies discusses economic issues such as capital gains tax, NAFTA, income distribution, the endangered species act, and national minerals policy forum, and poverty measurement. Press releases consist of a fact sheet delineating the functions of the Endangered Species Committee. Printed material contain clippings about a capital gains tax.

Reports from executive agencies address economics research related to issues such as global environment change (Department of the Interior), regulatory flexibility and market innovation (Commodity Futures Trading Commission), stock index futures (Commodity Futures Trading Commission), insurance and employment benefits (White House Task Force on Infant Mortality), and measurements of income and poverty (Working Group on Improving Economic Statistics).
