Provenance

Official records of George Bush's presidency and vice presidency are housed at the George Bush Presidential Library and administered by the National Archives and Records Administration (NARA) under the provisions of the Presidential Records Act (PRA).

Processed By

Staff Archivists, November 2018. Previously restricted materials are added as they are released.

System of Arrangement

Records that are responsive to this FOIA request were found in two collection areas—Bush Presidential Records: WHORM Subject Files and Bush Presidential Records: Staff and Office Files. As policy, WHORM Alphabetical Files and WHORM Subject Files are processed at the document level. Staff and Office Files are processed at the folder level, that is, individual documents are not selected and removed from a folder for processing. While this method maintains folder integrity, it frequently results in the incidental processing of documents that are not wholly responsive to the subject area.

The WHORM Subject File compiled by the White House Office of Records Management is comprised of a series of documents assigned a letter/number combination and filed in a subject category. A complete listing of the subject categories including a detailed description of each category is available in our research room and on our website at <http://bushlibrary.tamu.edu/research/find/whorm/whorm.html>.

Please note that a single asterisk "*" indicates that the category is entirely processed and open.

Scope and Content

The materials in FOIA 2017-2161-F are a selective, not necessarily all inclusive, body of documents responsive to the topic of the FOIA. Researchers should consult the archivist about related materials.

FOIA 2017-2161-F contains materials from agencies and individuals and highlight the relationship between Barbara Bush and Raisa Gorbachev.

The WHORM Subject File categories contain correspondence concerning Mrs. Bush and Mrs. Gorbachev's visit to Wellesley College. These records also contain the initial letter from the sculptress concerning a "Make Way for Ducklings" statue in Moscow.

The Staff and Office Files contain correspondence, memoranda, and publications maintained by individual staff members and offices. These files contain articles, correspondence, and schedules related to the May 1990 summit in Moscow as well as additional materials concerning the "Make Way for Ducklings" statue.
