Provenance

Official records of George Bush's presidency and vice presidency are housed at the George Bush Presidential Library and administered by the National Archives and Records Administration (NARA) under the provisions of the Presidential Records Act (PRA).

Processed By

Staff Archivists, November 2018. Previously restricted materials are added as they are released.

System of Arrangement

Records that are responsive to this FOIA request were found in one collection area—Bush Presidential Records: Staff and Office Files. As policy, Staff and Office Files are processed at the folder level, that is, individual documents are not selected and removed from a folder for processing. While this method maintains folder integrity, it frequently results in the incidental processing of documents that are not wholly responsive to the subject area.

Related material may be found in FOIA request 1998-0528-F entitled "First Lady Barbara Bush Speech Material."

Scope and Content

The materials in FOIA 2017-2164-F are a selective, not necessarily all inclusive, body of documents responsive to the topic of the FOIA. Researchers should consult the archivist about related materials.

FOIA 2017-2164-F contains materials from agencies and individuals including the First Lady's Office, the Office of the Vice President, and the Republican National Committee.

The Staff and Office Files contain speech drafts and texts of Mrs. Bush's speech, including remarks by her grandson, George P. Bush. In addition, schedules, notes, and lists of events, attendees, and logistics reveal the organizing of the 1992 Republican National Convention. Correspondence, invitations, press releases, seating charts and programs shed additional light on the Convention.
