Access

Copyright

Documents in this collection that were prepared by officials of the United States government as part of their official duties are in the public domain. Researchers are advised to consult the copyright law of the United States (Title 17, USC) which governs the making of photocopies or other reproductions of copyrighted material.

Provenance

Official records of George Bush's presidency and vice presidency are housed at the George Bush Presidential Library and administered by the National Archives and Records Administration (NARA) under the provisions of the Presidential Records Act (PRA).

Processed By

Staff Archivists, March 2018. Previously restricted materials are added as they are released.

System of Arrangement

Records that are responsive to this FOIA request were found in two collection areas—Bush Vice Presidential Records: Subject Files and Bush Vice Presidential Records: Staff and Office Files. As policy, WHORM Alphabetical Files and WHORM Subject Files are processed at the document level. Staff and Office Files are processed at the folder level, that is, individual documents are not selected and removed from a folder for processing. While this method maintains folder integrity, it frequently results in the

incidental processing of documents that are not wholly responsive to the subject area.

The WHORM Subject File compiled by the White House Office of Records Management is comprised of a series of documents assigned a letter/number combination and filed in a subject category. A complete listing of the subject categories including a detailed description of each category is available in our research room and on our website at <http://bushlibrary.tamu.edu/research/find/whorm/whorm.html>.

Please note that a single asterisk "*" indicates that the category is entirely processed and open.

Scope and Content

The materials in FOIA 2018-0468-F are a selective, not necessarily all inclusive, body of documents responsive to the topic of the FOIA. Researchers should consult the archivist about related materials.

FOIA 2018-0468-F contains selected materials concerning Vice President Bush's 1986 trip to Vancouver, British Columbia and Ottawa, Quebec.

The Vice Presidential Subject File category contains a 1988 invitation to the Second Arctic Policy Conference.

The Staff and Office Files contain articles, correspondence, papers, press releases, remarks, schedules, and talking points. There are articles concerning U.S.-Canada relations. Papers and talking points provide background on issues such as trade as well as the general purpose and expected outcome of the June 1986 trip. There are final and draft remarks for the Vice President for a number of events including a breakfast with the Vancouver Board of Trade and a luncheon hosted by Prime Minister Brian Mulroney. There is also a schedule for the Vancouver portion of the trip.
