Access

Access to Bush Presidential Records, Bush Vice Presidential Records, and Quayle Vice Presidential Records is governed by the Freedom of Information Act (FOIA)(5 USC 552 as amended) and the Presidential Records Act (PRA)(44 USC 22) and therefore records may be restricted in whole or in part in accordance with legal exemptions.

Provenance

Official records of George Bush's presidency and vice presidency are housed at the George Bush Presidential Library and administered by the National Archives and Records Administration (NARA) under the provisions of the Presidential Records Act (PRA).

Processed By

Staff Archivists, May 2019. Previously restricted materials are added as they are released.

System of Arrangement

Records that are responsive to this FOIA request were found in one collection area—Bush Vice Presidential Records: Staff and Office Files. Staff and Office Files are processed at the folder level, that is, individual documents are not selected and removed from a folder for processing. While this method maintains folder integrity, it frequently results in the incidental processing of documents that are not wholly responsive to the subject area.

Scope and Content

The materials in FOIA 2018-0914-F are a selective, not necessarily all inclusive, body of documents responsive to the topic of the FOIA. Researchers should consult the archivist about related materials.

FOIA 2018-0914-F contains materials from agencies and individuals including the Vice Presidential Office of Administration and Mrs. Bush's Office. The occasion was a trip by Mrs. Bush to West Middlesex and Sharpsville, Pennsylvania, to attend a reception for Tom Ridge's Congressional campaign and, after that, a church service in celebration of the 100th anniversary of the Universalist Church building. The church was built on the site of the home of Mrs. Bush's ancestor, General James A. Pierce.

The Staff and Office Files contain correspondence, expense reports, invitations, memoranda, receipts, schedules, and travel authorizations. Records from the Office of Administration deal with the preparations for Mrs. Bush's trip to Sharpsville, Pennsylvania, including receipts and expense reports. Those from Mrs. Bush's Office consist of correspondence related to the visits, both invitations before the events and thank you notes from after the events. There are also schedules and travel authorizations for the events.
