#### **Access**

Collection is open to all researchers. Access to Bush Presidential Records, Bush Vice Presidential Records, and Quayle Vice Presidential Records is governed by the Freedom of Information Act (FOIA)(5 USC 552 as amended) and the Presidential Records Act (PRA)(44 USC 22) and therefore records may be restricted in whole or in part in accordance with legal exemptions.

#### **Copyright**

Documents in this collection that were prepared by officials of the United States government as part of their official duties are in the public domain. #### **Provenance**

Official records of George Bush's presidency and vice presidency are housed at the George Bush Presidential Library and administered by the National Archives and Records Administration (NARA) under the provisions of the Presidential Records Act (PRA).

#### **Processed By**

Staff Archivists, March 2019. Previously restricted materials are added as they are released.

#### **System of Arrangement**

Records that are responsive to this FOIA request were found in one collection area—Bush Presidential Records: Staff and Office Files. Staff and Office Files are processed at the folder level, that is, individual documents are not selected and removed from a folder for processing. While this method maintains folder integrity, it frequently results in the incidental processing of documents that are not wholly

responsive to the subject area.

### **Scope and Content**

FOIA 2019-0643-F contains materials from the White House Office of Public Liaison, specifically from staff member Leigh Ann Metzger. These materials include travel authorizations for Doug Wead, personal correspondence to Mr. Wead from Jack Hayford and the Oral Roberts Commencement Address given by Mr. Wead on May 5, 1990. Other materials include magazines containing articles provided by President Bush and subject files with general, various information on the Assembly of God and Pentecostal faiths.
