# **Biographical Note**

Torkel Patterson served as Director for Asian Affairs from 1991–1993. His primary areas of responsibility included Japan, Korea and Asian business issues. Prior to coming to the NSC, Patterson was the Senior Country Director for Japan in the Office of the Assistance Secretary of Defense from 1988–1991. He later returned to the NSC as Senior Director for Asian Affairs from 2001–2002.

# **Scope and Content**

The materials in this collection are a systematically processed body of documents responsive to the topic. Researchers should consult the archivist about related materials.

Case Number 2022-0474-S contains correspondence, reports, printed material, speeches, press releases and public statements related to Patterson's primary areas of responsibility. The internal correspondence addresses administrative issues such as meeting and travel arrangements. The balance of the records discuss issues such as trade and business issues, foreign relations, political and military cooperation, and foreign assistance.

It should be noted that a significant number of the documents listed here are security classified and have been closed under the restrictions of the Freedom of Information Act.
