Staff and Office Files are processed at the folder level, that is, individual documents are not selected and removed from a folder for processing. While this method maintains folder integrity, it frequently results in the incidental processing of documents that are not wholly responsive to the subject area.

Biographical Note

A. Blair Dorminey served as Director for Policy Planning from 1988 to 1990. His primary areas of responsibility included immigration and Southeast Asian refugees. Prior to working in the Bush White House, Dorminey served as Special Assistant to the President's Domestic Policy Advisor from 1987 to 1988.

Scope and Content

The materials in this collection are a systematically processed body of documents responsive to the topic. Researchers should consult the archivist about related materials.

Case Number 2022-0906-S contains correspondence, papers, reports, speeches, and printed material related to issues such as refugee and asylum policy, foreign economic assistance, human rights, and President Bush's use of the phrase "new world order."

It should be noted that a significant number of the documents listed here are security classified and have been closed under the restrictions of the Freedom of Information Act.
