System of Arrangement

Records for this systematic project were found in the following collection area—Bush Presidential Records: Staff and Office Files. Staff and Office Files are processed at the folder level, that is, individual documents are not selected and removed from a folder for processing. While this method maintains folder integrity, it frequently results in the incidental processing of documents that are not wholly responsive to the subject area.

Biographical Note

Craig Chellis served as Director for Defense Policy and Arms Controls from 1992 to 1993. Michael D. Fry served as Director for Defense Policy and Arms Control from 1990 to 1992. Their primary areas of responsibility included arms control, proliferation, NATO, Open Skies, CFE and CSCE.

Scope and Content

The materials in this collection are a systematically processed body of documents responsive to the topic. Researchers should consult the archivist about related materials.

Case Number 2023-0016-S contains correspondence, papers, press releases, printed material, speeches and talking points addressing topics such as arms control, the Conventional Armed Forces in Europe (CFE) Treaty, the Commission on Security and Cooperation in Europe (CSCE), the Forum for Security Cooperation (FSC), and the Open Skies Treaty.
