Processed By

System of Arrangement

Records for this systematic project were found in the following collection area—Bush Presidential Records: Staff and Office Files. Staff and Office Files are processed at the folder level, that is, individual documents are not selected and removed from a folder for processing. While this method maintains folder integrity, it frequently results in the incidental processing of documents that are not wholly responsive to the subject area.

Biographical Note

The president's Assistant for Legislative Affairs, Frederick D. McClure, provided advice and support regarding the president's legislative agenda and legislation in general, and coordinated interaction between the White House staff and members of Congress. The office provided the president with a weekly legislative report in which key legislation and actions of Congress were outlined and discussed. Staff members were each assigned to different Congressional committees and were responsible for tracking legislation through the committee process, meeting with committee members and staff, and keeping the Assistant to the President for Legislative Affairs informed about committee activities. E. Boyd Hollingsworth, who served as McClure's deputy, maintained general oversight of all committees and issues and delegated specific committee oversight to Special Assistants to the President for Legislative Affairs. James W. Dyer served as Deputy Assistant to the President for Legislative Affairs (Senate) from March 31, 1991 until January 3, 1993.

Scope and Content

The materials in Case Number 2023-0111-S are a systematically processed body of documents responsive to the topic. Researchers should consult the archivist about related materials.

These records consist of memos, outlines, and White House forms. The memos consist mainly of communications to James W. Dyer regarding seating on Air Force One, a 'heads up' on a personnel matter, and an announcement of an Economic Policy Council meeting containing discussion points. There is also a copy of a memo sent to President Bush and members of the Economic Policy Council describing the implementation of Special 301 and Title VII provisions of the 1988 Omnibus Trade Act. The White House forms are mainly staffing memos which route documents to multiple administrative officials plus fax transmittal sheets.
