### **Scope and Content**

The materials in Case Number 2023-0678-S are a systematically processed body of documents responsive to the topic. Researchers should consult the archivist about related materials.

Case Number 2023-0678-S contains one folder of materials created by James Schaefer related to President Bush’s meeting with Cardinal John O’Connor of New York. The Office of Public Liaison coordinated activities, events, and relations between various public interest groups and constituencies and the Bush Administration. Schaefer served as Assistant Director and Special Assistant to the Deputy Assistant to the President for Public Liaison from January 1991 until April 1992. He then was named Associate Director for Public Liaison in April 1992 and served until January 1993. His areas of expertise included Military, Arab Groups, Eastern Europe.

The Staff and Office Files contain memos, a document, lists, handwritten notes, diagrams, and forms. Correspondence in this folder are memos supplying background information on, and details about, President Bush’s meeting with Cardinal O’Connor. A document contains points for President Bush to make during the meeting. There are lists of meeting participants, handwritten notes related to various aspects of the meeting, and diagrams reflecting seating charts of meeting participants. Forms present in this folder contain a White House scheduling recommendation, and a conference room request.
