Scope and Content

The materials in 2010-2616-S are a selective, not necessarily all inclusive, body of documents. Researchers should consult the archivist about related materials. C0001 is a secondary subject category containing cables, coversheets, forms, letters, constituent letters urging the Administration to re-evaluate U.S. Policy toward apartheid in South Africa, and a memo from Edward J. Derwinski to the President regarding the Republican Heritage Community's stance on Soviet and East European relations.
