#### Access

Collection is open to all researchers. Access to Bush Presidential Records, Bush Vice Presidential Records, and Quayle Vice Presidential Records is governed by the Freedom of Information Act (FOIA)(5 USC 552 as amended) and the Presidential Records Act (PRA)(44 USC 22) and therefore records may be restricted in whole or in part in accordance with legal exemptions.

#### Copyright

Documents in this collection that were prepared by officials of the United States government as part of their official duties are in the public domain. Researchers are advised to consult the copyright law of the United States (Title 17, USC) which governs the making of photocopies or other reproductions of copyrighted material.

#### Provenance

Official records of George Bush's presidency and vice presidency are housed at the George Bush Presidential Library and administered by the National Archives and Records Administration (NARA) under the provisions of the Presidential Records Act (PRA).

#### Processed By

Staff Archivists, February 2010. Previously restricted materials are added as they are released.

#### Scope and Content

The materials in 2008-1193-F are a selective, not necessarily all inclusive, body of documents responsive to the topic of the FOIA. Researchers should consult the archivist about related materials. FG013-06 is a secondary subject category containing correspondence, cover sheets, forms, memoranda, nominations, photographs, press releases, resumes, and speeches regarding the Joint Chiefs of Staff. Topics discussed include the nomination of Colin Powell as Chairman and requests for General Powell's participation in speaking engagements.

#### System of Arrangement

The WHORM Subject File compiled by the White House Office of Records Management is comprised of a

series of documents assigned a letter/number combination and filed in a subject category.
